Primary Role

We are looking for an enthusiastic Ranch Hand to help with barn chores, feeding horses, and facilities projects.

The Details

- Sunday through Thursday, starting Sunday May 2
- Estimated 2-4 weeks (minimum of 2 weeks)
- Must be on property and ready to start feeding hay by 7:30am
- Flexibility on end time, depending upon the weather & volunteer coverage (assume until at least 12:00pm)

Example Day

Feeding hay by 7:30am

Refill waters (break through ice when needed)

Other barn shift support as needed, including mucking, throwing hay, cleaning barn

Monitoring and filling gas tanks on ATVs and trucks

Check and repair fencing

Facilities issues that arise

Compensation

This is an hourly position that pays \$15/hour.

Work Environment and Physical Requirements

Work is performed in a horse barn and outdoor setting. This position is potentially subject to animal bites, scratches, kicks, and unpredictable dangerous situations. Frequent lifting to 50 lbs. with reasonable accommodations. Frequent walking, standing, bending, stooping, movement, and repetitive motion. Work outside in weather extremes, both heat and cold.
